The environment that advisors and our clients live and work within is changing faster than it ever has. Governments are short of cash and are finding new and inventive ways of raising funds from taxpayers. Governments are approaching this with a carrot and stick approach. On the one hand offering incentives to attract individuals and their money to their jurisdictions, and on the other are introducing information gathering provisions and penalty regimes on the taxpayers and their advisers.

The UK's system of taxing UK resident but non domiciled individuals is relatively well known and understood, but there are many other countries that offer competing regimes that are less well known. Certain countries have also established special arrangements for taxation of holding companies with a view to attracting capital and revenue.

STEP's International Client Special Interest Group will bring together specialists from around the world who will explain developments in many jurisdictions and provide attendees with an understanding of some the different opportunities available to their clients, as well as the advantages on offer and the pitfalls.


